

Glass at Central

Book Launch

There will be a book launch here at the Cochrane Gallery as part of the Glass at Central conference on the evening of Sun 18 September, from 6pm onwards.

Glass at Central is a fascinating account of the last twentyfive years of the Stained glass course at the Central Saint Martins College of Art and Design. The courses offered had included the Postgraduate Course of Professional Studies in Glass as well as evening and weekend classes and summer schools. All these have now been closed down, due to re-structuring of the whole college which coincided with the move to new premises at the Granary Warehouse at Kings Cross.

This book recollects the history of the course, placing particular emphasis on the last 25 years. It features work and achievements of over 110 alumni as well as recollections by students and staff, who share their memories of being at CSM, their artists statements and what they have been doing since leaving the college.

This book presents the rich and varied work in glass by alumni of the various glass courses in highly illustrated entries on 204 pages.

Hildegard Pax is a former tutor on the course and a practising glass artist, working with glass in a Fine Art as well as an Architectural context and has completed glass commissions in the UK and in Germany.
